ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP POLICY

Any family can become members of Sierra Hills Club subject to the approval of the Board of Directors. Any family wishing to become members of the Club must first complete application for membership and sign a letter of intent. Upon completion, if there are no membership spaces available, the application will be placed on a waiting list. When a space becomes available the prospective member must pay a one-time \$150 initiation fee. This fee is refundable if the application is not approved. Upon approval, the member family agrees to abide by the rules of the Club and the By-Laws of the Corporation and understands that its voting rights in the Corporation are limited.

RESIDENT FAMILIES OF SIERRA HILLS (DEANE HOMES) MAY NOT BECOME ASSOCIATE MEMBERS.

DUES POLICY

Dues are payable the first of each month, i.e. January dues are payable on January 1st. A member is considered delinquent upon non-receipt of dues. Associate members who become delinquent by 60 days (two months) will be notified **one time only**. Membership will be terminated if full payment is not made. To aid in dues payment, each member receives a coupon book good for twenty-four months.

GUEST POLICY

While using the tennis courts, each member may have one guest accompany him or her. While using the swimming pool, each member may have one guest accompany him or her. The same guest may use the facilities only one time per week, regardless if the same or a different member brings that guest. All guests entering the pool area must register at the office window.

A HOUSE GUEST is considered to be anyone staying at a member's home overnight. House guests must be registered with the Club for the duration of the visit to enjoy the privileges of the regular members.

When the swimming pool is open, both swimmers and tennis players must sign up at the office window. When the pool is closed, tennis players enter the courts through the play yard. There is a tennis key deposit of \$50.00, which is returned upon the return of Tennis Key. If you lose the key the deposit is not refunded. You may purchase a second key for purchased for \$5.00. If one is lost or you need a third key for any reason, the third key is \$10.00.

MEMBERS OF THOSE FAMILIES WHO LIVE IN SIERRA HILLS (DEANE HOMES) BUT DO NOT HOLD MEMBERSHIP IN THE CLUB MAY NOT USE THE

CLUB FACILITIES AS A GUEST OF A CLUB MEMBER OR ATTEND SOCIAL
FUNCTIONS AS A GUEST.

POOL RULES

1. Swimming is permitted only with a lifeguard on duty. Exception: adults who sign a release to swim, & swim only when office is open.
2. Guests are allowed only when accompanied by a member. All guests must sign in at the office window before entering.
3. Children under six, or anyone who cannot swim the length of the pool, must be accompanied by an adult or responsible adult.
4. The shallow 2 foot wading area is only for small children who cannot swim or (under six years of age) and must be watched by an adult at poolside.
5. No running or horseplay of any kind is allowed on the pool deck.
6. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time. Dives must be made straight off the board only. Only straight dives and straight jumps are allowed.
7. The area under and around the diving board should be kept clear at all times.
8. No skateboards, roller skates, bicycles, roller blades, etc. are allowed inside the pool area. These items should be left at home. Sierra Hills is not responsible for lost or stolen property of any kind.
9. No inner-tubes, beach toys or flotation devices, or scuba gear of any kind, are allowed in the pool. Non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult.
10. No gum or glass bottles are allowed inside the pool area. Picnicking is allowed only on the grass area and barbeque area by the pool area.
11. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area, except at Club functions.
12. No unauthorized person or anyone wearing a wet bathing suit is allowed inside the clubhouse, office, storage, or filter areas.
13. The phone in the office is for business and emergency calls only. We will page guests if they have an emergency phone call. The phone number is 252-3080.
14. No animals of any kind are allowed in the pool area or clubhouse.

15. The lifeguard towers are for authorized personnel only. No one should hang on or jump from either tower.
16. The office manager has final authority concerning all violations of these and any other Club rules. If there are any questions concerning Club policy, these should be directed to the office and not the lifeguards.
17. If a violation occurs, the violator(s) may be asked to leave for a specified time period (as determined by the person in the office). A report will be made and the parents will be called if appropriate. Minors may only return to the Club after a parent has been reached and the specified time period has elapsed.
18. Most importantly, parents should leave a telephone number where they can be reached, if they are not at home, in case the Club needs to contact them.
19. There are no waivers to these rules at anytime.

TENNIS COURT RULES

1. Singles may play for 60 minutes if others are waiting to play. Doubles may play for 120 minutes, this includes warm-up. There is no increasing time by juggling individuals in and out of play group. **(These rules are for open play only; are not reservation play rules.)**
2. Children: only those that play tennis may enter tennis court area. Please leave children who do not play tennis in the play area.
3. After 5:00pm, those 14 years and younger must be accompanied by a participating adult.
4. Each member may have one guest accompany him/her on the court.
5. A court may not be held by one person.
6. Appropriate tennis attire and tennis shoes (no black sole shoes allowed) must be worn.
7. All tennis lessons must be approved by the Board of Directors. Tennis lessons may be given to members only.
8. Tennis play is strictly limited to the hours between 6:00am and 12:00midnight. Anyone playing after hours will be escorted off the courts.

TENNIS RESERVATIONS CONTINUED....

9. Reservations may be made:

Monday – Friday 6:00pm – 10:00pm
Saturday– Sunday 6:00am – 12:00 noon

Note: Singles may reserve a court for 1 hour; if playing
Doubles you may reserve the court For 2 hours.

RENTAL POLICY

1. The Club is available for rental to Club members only. It is intended that such rental be for private social functions, for the Club member and guests, and not for money making ventures with an admission charge. The Board of Directors reserve the right to determine if a particular rental should be classified as a commercial venture and consequently be disallowed or must pay an additional fee.
2. The Club member must sign the License Agreement and Lockup Responsibility forms and see that the conditions therein are fulfilled.
3. Rental fees vary according to the type of function and the number of people attending. If on rare occasion where we allow the renter to clean the Club (instead of our clean-up charge), the Club must be cleaned thoroughly. All or part of the deposit will be forfeited if clean-up is incomplete.
4. Only members may rent the clubhouse and any guests of honor must be included on rental agreement.
5. If a rental of the clubhouse takes place during normal pool hours, the clubhouse will be reserved for the exclusive use of the rental group, but the pool will remain open to regular Club members.

PROPERTY LOAN POLICY

Club members may borrow long table, card tables, and folding chairs at no cost. The property must be signed out and returned on the date agreed upon.

ANY RULE MAY BE CHANGED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SIERRA HILLS SWIM AND RACQUET CLUB.
